June Session: Frequently Asked Questions

Please find the questions about the June sessions at Castleton State below. We are excited about this opportunity to come together, especially because it offers you the maximum choice and flexibility to work as a team, get information and resources you need, and refine your implementation plans.

What time will the days begin/end?

June 2: 8:30-4:30. (3 workshop sessions)

June 3: 8:30-3:00. (2 workshop sessions)

If teams wish to continue to meet in the evening of June 2, your team space will be available to you.

How many sessions will be offered each day?

All of the sessions will be offered on day one. Some will be repeated day one, some will be repeated day two.

How many times will each session be offered?

At least twice, and, in some cases, three times.

Will there be an opportunity for facilitated feedback sessions? Consultancies or tuning protocols?

Might you consider running 2 strands? Some of these are more classroom/bottom of the pyramid and others are more systems/top of the pyramid. I wouldn't want the systems sessions to conflict (assessing transfer / grading).

Will workshops be more in depth informational on topic along with processes to structure with faculty?

The intent of the sessions--as with the series--is to ensure you have tools, resources, and processes to lead the work in your district/SU.

Will sessions provide time for planning?

Planning time in the workshop sessions will be limited, but you will have team time as well.



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Can we attend different workshops and de-brief as a team and share new learning?

Yes. Your team can determine how to best spend its time--including dividing up to different sessions as necessary.
