| YES                    | Transcripts and Report Cards | <div>Content-Area Graduation Standards<br/>5–8 standards for each content area</div> <div>Verification of Proficiency</div> <div>Students demonstrate achievement of content-area graduation standards through their aggregate performance on summative assessments over time</div>   |
| NO                     | Progress Reports             | <div>Performance Indicators</div> <div>5–10 indicators for each cross-curricular and content-area standard that move students toward proficiency and the achievement of graduation standards</div> <div>Summative Assessment</div> <div>Graded summative assessments are used to evaluate the achievement of performance indicators</div> |
| NO                     | Teacher Feedback             | <div>Learning Objectives</div> <div>Learning objectives guide the design of curriculum units that move students toward proficiency and the achievement of performance indicators</div> <div>Formative Assessment</div> <div>Ungraded formative assessments are used to evaluate student learning progress</div>                           |



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
