2) What evidence do you see of how students’ mastery of this performance indicator changes over time (looking at evidence from different grade levels)?

3) In what ways might this scoring criteria might be useful in assessing these different pieces of student work? What challenges might arise from using this scoring criteria to assess these different pieces of student work?

4) What new insights did you gain from reviewing this student work?
